ELIGIBILITY: Any current surgery resident or vascular fellow in Georgia.

AWARDS: An award of \$500.00 for the best resident/fellow abstract and oral presentation will be presented during the 2022 Scientific Sessions of the Georgia Vascular Society to be held at The Ritz-Carlton Reynolds, Lake Oconee, in Greensboro, GA, September 9-11, 2022.

PROGRAM SELECTION COMMITTEE: The Program Committee will review and approve all abstracts to be included in the Scientific Program. All abstracts must be submitted no later than May 2, 2022.

ABSTRACT: The best abstracts will be selected based upon the originality and scientific merit. The content of the investigative work must represent original work in clinical research or basic investigation. The material must not have been presented, submitted or published elsewhere.
